The only difference between an Active Shooter and Active Assailant is the weapon they are using, both are trying to cause great bodily harm or kill. Law Enforcement personnel will respond to both in the same manner.

- x If you cannot safely run, then you must take cover and hide.
- x If in a classroom, lock the door
- x If you cannot lock the doorbarricade it.
- x Turn of the lights and be as quiet as possible.
- x Call 911. Seak softly and them know your location and what is happening you cannot speak leave the phone line open.
- x If you have the Lion Safe Apphen use the text feature torelay information directly to the Police Dispatcher.
- x Staycalm and on't open the door untila Police Officer instructs you to.evify it is a police officer by either them being known to you or bycalling dispatch to see if they are at your location.

<u>FIGHT</u>:

- x If you cannot run or hidethen fight.
- x This is a last resorbut fight as hard as you can.
- x Use anything to distract or disable the assailant
- x Fight in large groups to overwhelm the assailant.
- x Don't give up!YOUR life depends on it.

Any situation cancause panic or fearLust the unknown will cause individuals to get tunnel visione(focusing on one thing). The body will go into fight of flight mode. One must be ready to reast the situation will cause many unknowns.

It is possible that the building's fire alarms will be sounding the fire suppression sprinklers may be going of thers will be running and screaming. You may encounter injured persdusing your exit. Several things you must remember as you exit.

- x Have your hands raised high or at a minimum visible to first responders.
- x As hard as it may be, don't stop to help others
- x Listen to all commands given by responding law enforcement.
- x Oncesafe, notify someone you are O.K

How will you know of an Active Assailant or Emergency Situation of pash

The University Police will send out an Emergency Notification to your registered email and call the listed phone number you have provided in LeoNet. As long as you have not opted out, you will receive a text along with the call and email.

Go to LeoNet and make sure all your information is correct and that you have not opted out of getting emergency texts.

The University will also send out a push notification on the Lion Safe App, giving you the emergency information. To sign-up for the Lion Safe appxisit the Apple or Google stores and download the app for free.
