"Student" includes all persons taking courses at the University whether full time, part time, **duadly**ed, visiting, online, for noncredit, or pursuing undergraduate, graduate, professional studies or degree seeking lso included are those who attend postcondaryeducational institutions other than Southeaster Louisiana University and who reside in University residence halls.

"Employee" means any person having an employment relationship with the University, including but not limited to classifie dand unclassified taff, faculty, graduate assistant and student employees.

SectionI. GeneralUniversity Regulations

This section of the policy applies to all University students, employees and guests.

 In addition, an event could be considered a student organization event if a non-member perceives the event as being sponsore by an organization.

Students and those affiliated with the organization should refer to the Student Organizationhol Event Procedures for a full list of action items an organization must complete before impuse vents where alcoholis served will be approved

B. GeneraRegulations

- A contract with the UniversityPoliceDepartmentmust be signed for anyon campus eventwhere alcohol
 will be served. Its recommended that Local awenforcement be contracted for events occurring off
 campus
- Studentorganizationsmay not distribute alcoholicbeveragesfree of charge.
- No organization may esponsor an event with an alcohol distributor, charitable anization avern, or where alcoholis given away, sold, or otherwise provided to those present.
- Alcoholon campuswill be allowed only at catered Food Service wents and will be sold by Dining Services personne brapproved licensed servers.
- Alcohol,bartabs,couponsfor free or reduced priced drinks, etc., may not be awarded a prizes for any rafflesor other events.
- Alcoholmaynot be distributedfree of chargeby an alcoholcompanyor distributor at anystudent organizationevent under any circumstance on campus.
- The cost of alcoholic beverages may not be included in the cost of an admission ticket, cover charge, or any other assessment equired of members or quests.
- Vendors/serverare responsible or assuring that no personunder the age of 21 is served look.

- At homegames, alcohol, cups, containers, ice chest, etc; cannot be brought into the venue and all persons entering the venue are subject to a reasonable check/search of personal thanks, coats, etc.
 - Anyonefound in possession alcoholic beverage (other than those sold in the venue) and/or other items deemed dangerous rinappropriate will be refused admissior to the game
 - o Anyindividual found in possession of said items will be evicted from the venue and will not be allowed to re-enter the venue for the remainder of the calendar day on white game is held.
 - Alcoholmay be purchased nside the venue by those of legal age with valid identification
- Failure of follow these rules and regulations may result in eviction from campus with possible University ocal, or state action to follow.
